

**Hartley City Council Meeting
Special Session
September 27, 2016**

The special meeting of the Hartley City Council was held Monday September 27, 2016 at 5:15 p.m. in the Hartley City Hall. Mayor John Lyman presided and called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. City Council Members present were: Ron Hengeveld, Roxann Swanson and Mary Westphalen. Absent: Jerry Olson & Val Moermond. Others present: Patty Anderson and Terry Hilbert.

Westphalen moved to approve the agenda. Seconded by Hengeveld. Roll Call: Ayes. Hengeveld, Swanson and Westphalen. Nays. None. Motion carried 3-0.

At 5:17 p.m. Westphalen moved to go into a closed session per Iowa Code Section 21.5 (1) (j) to "Discuss the Purchase of Particular Real Estate only". Seconded by Swanson. Roll Call: Ayes. Swanson, Westphalen and Hengeveld. Nays. None. Motion Carried 3-0.

At 5:41 p.m. the Council returned to open session.

No action was taken on Agenda Item No. 7 Approve Real Estate Offer.

Terry Hilbert informed that the City Hall sidewalk project was complete and the sign will be reset Monday. He asked the Council if they wanted to seed the lawn. It was a consensus of the Council to seed this fall. The City is trying out two types of LED lights on certain Iowa Highway 18 light poles. He asked the Council to look at them.

Mayor Lyman informed he spoke with a Mayor in another City at the Iowa League of Cities Conference and asked about having them look at some of Hartley's homes. They have helped other cities in the past.
