Storm Season Safety; the people most at risk in any severe weather situation are those who are not aware of the threat. Once aware of an impending threat, action can be taken to protect yourself, your family and friends, and if time allows, sometimes your property.



When it comes to severe weather, Hartley's siren may be activated. Outdoor sirens have one purpose – to alert people who are outdoors that something dangerous may happen and to seek shelter. A test of the siren occurs on the first Wednesday of every month at about noon.

The primary indoor warning device is a NOAA weather radio. These radios are relatively inexpensive and quite reliable. Portable versions are also available for use outdoors or when traveling. When the National Weather Service issues a warning, these weather radios automatically alarm and broadcast the warning, allowing people to take appropriate action.

Please Remove All Wreaths and Artificial Decorations From the Cemetery Before Monday, June 5th, 2017. Decorations that are part of the foundation or stone itself are exempt from this notice. Any decorations remaining after this date **WILL BE DISPOSED OF** so the caretaker can maintain the Cemetery properly.

Branches can be taken to the City tree dump located east of town. There are separate locations at the City dump where leaves and cut grass can be placed. Only branches, leaves, and cut grass will be accepted at these sites.

Curb Side Collection is the last Wednesday of each month from April through October. Branches and bagged or boxed leaves and grass clippings will be collected.

When mowing, do not allow grass clippings to enter the City street and gutter. Grass clippings can block rainfall from flowing into storm water intakes.
